FCC order requires broadcasters to notify the FCC if their station broadcasts a false EAS alert and has enacted a requirement to do so within 24hrs of becoming aware email FCC Ops FCCOPS@fcc.gov

**State monthly tests (RMT)** required and must be re-transmitted within 60 minutes of the time they are received. (RMT) like actual alert activations are requested to be run with original audio payload. This validates store and forward capability

**FCC's Part 11 Rules** provide for odd-numbered months, the RMT will be scheduled between 8:30 a.m. and local sunset; during even-numbered months, RMT is to be scheduled between local sunset and 8:30 a.m. Weekly tests are not required during the week a RMT is conducted

**EAS Activations:** If a RMT is missed in any given month, notify CT SECC, Run a RWT as substitute and note in your log accordingly. Although RMT may be skipped in any month in which EAS is activated as per §11.51, CT Broadcasters have requested the SECC continue with the normal RMT schedule regardless if the system is activated or not for continuity of recordkeeping reasons.

**SRN - State Relay Network TELCO and VHF links are closed circuit ADR tested each week**

**This access to the public alert uses technology that is not internet dependent!**
